An exciting two week Summer Theatre School session for actors 4 years old through 2nd grade. Students are divided into grade levels to develop skills in acting, improvisation, rehearsal techniques, voice and diction, communication, character development, creative thinking, play making, dance, movement and much more.

Who Teaches?

Instructors all have training and/or degrees in theatre. Some are Grandstreet staff or former students attending universities across the country. Others are professional actors or theatre professionals from around the country.
