What if I am sick or have an emergency situation?

You will only be excused if you call before rehearsal we will not call you to find out where you are. The Stage Manager will not take calls during rehearsal.

If you have any of the following symptoms please let your stage managers know before/during rehearsal/performance:

In the interest of providing a safe and healthy environment for our actors and students, Grandstreet Theatre School would like to ask for your cooperation in keeping your child at home if he/she is sick. GSTS considers a child too ill to come to rehearsal or class if any of the following symptoms are present:

Chicken Pox

Fever (101°F)

Vomiting and/or Diarrhea

Rash (which has not been diagnosed by a physician)

Lice

Ringworm

Impetigo (child must be treated with antibiotics for 24 hours prior to attendance)

Conjunctivitis : commonly known as pink eye

Strep throat

Grandstreet Theatre School has hand sanitizer dispensers. Everyone is encouraged to use the sanitizers upon arrival and to wash hands thoroughly with warm/hot water. Sing happy birthday to yourself twice while washing your hands. ☺
