Just a reminder that there are no conflicts allowed during dress rehearsal week (Nov. 27-Nov 30) and the rehearsals are from 6:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.

Here is the schedule for dress rehearsals:

5:50 – arrival and sign in

Everyone should come with hair and make-up already done. Please consult the email sent on November 13th for hair, make-up, shoes, etc. Everyone should wear black socks unless directed otherwise. **Please remember, no food or drink in costume.**

6:00-get into costume

6:45-notes

7:00-Pre-show choir, ushers, sellers go to places. At this point you must stay in the classroom. You may use the actor's bathroom and get drinks from the sink or your personal water bottle.

7:30-Show begins

9:00 –put all of your things in your backpack/bag and clean up the classroom

9:05 -block curtain call

9:15 hang up costumes in the same place you found them

9:25-notes

10:00- dismissal (unless you're on clean up duty)

Suggestions for things to do and bring for the show

Pack a bag with books, games, cards, etc. We have some at the theatre too. You might want to bring a carpet square or blanket to sit on. A water bottle with your name on it is a good idea but we seem to end up with MANY of them in the lost and found. If you bring expensive electronics well.....I wouldn't.

1. Raffle tickets for a trip to your dream vacation are on sale. Tickets are \$20.00 or three for \$50.00. The drawing will be held Dec. 17th. There are prizes for the theatre school student who sells the most tickets. 1st prize is \$100.00, for every 2 tickets sold (after you sell ten) you will be entered in a drawing for more prizes. **Your child is required to sell 3 tickets.** The value of this raffle is approx 5000.00 .**All ticket money must be turned in by Dec. 8th.** Every time you turn in money for tickets you may check out more tickets. This raffle is being sponsored by Flathead Travel Service.
2. **Once performances begin** (Friday, December 1st) you may pick your child up after the show in the classroom. The show should run about 1 ½ hours. Everyone will have clean-up duty at least once during the run. Please check the schedule attached, on the wall in the classroom or the “Rehearsal schedule” on the website. If your child is scheduled for clean up they will need to stay an extra 15 minutes on that day, otherwise they should be done and ready to be picked up by about 9:00 and 4:00. Please pick them up in the classroom.

3. The dance is for Theatre school students and their families only. Here is the schedule:

Saturday, December 9th

9:00-11:00 Dance at Carroll College (downstairs in the cube.)

This is certainly not mandatory but I wanted to give you a heads up so your child doesn't come home sad if they don't receive anything. We do not allow flowers to be given out on stage at curtain call. It is tradition in the theatre that those things are delivered to the green room before the show. **Please no latex balloons.**
