

Information about Rehearsals and Performances

Please pick the actors up on time.

Please be ready to work before your call time.

No food/gum or drink (except water bottles with names) in rehearsal.

If you are going to be late or if you are really, really sick please call or text the stage manager (Rick Johnson 461-1099) or Assistant Stage manager (Kendall Skoog 458-5220) BEFORE REHEARSAL. IF YOU WAIT UNTIL WE CALL YOU , IT WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED AN EXCUSED ABSENCE AND YOU WILL BE REPLACED IN THE PRODUCTION.

No conflicts may be added to your sheet. If something comes up you will have to choose between going to that event or remaining in the show. **PLEASE DON'T EVEN ASK!**

Please bring homework, books, playing cards, coloring books and board games to rehearsal/performances. Headphones and computer games are not encouraged.

If you need help with homework please check the bulletin board for a tutor list.

All rehearsals are closed to staff only (if you need to stay during rehearsal please ask a staff member for a job).

Once performances start we will assign clean up duties after the show. If your child is on the clean up list for that day they will need to stay an extra 15 minutes.

Always bring a pencil.

If you have been issued a script those must returned in good shape or there is a \$30.00 fine.

Do not criticize other actors or direct other actors.
