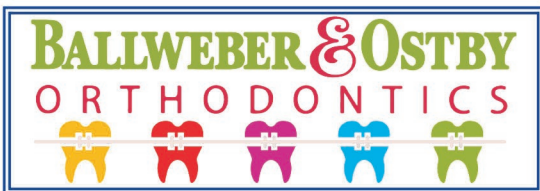

Since some of our patrons at today's show may be new to live theatre or returning after a long absence—here are a few tips and reminders about watching live theatre.

First of all, thank you for supporting live theatre, live theatre in Montana and Grandstreet Theatre in particular. Thank you for trusting us by returning to Grandstreet or joining us for the first time.

TIPS & REMINDERS

- Always cooperate with the ushers and front-of-house staff. They are there to help you, keep an orderly environment, and ensure the show begins as scheduled.

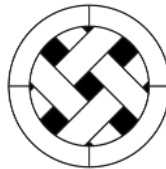

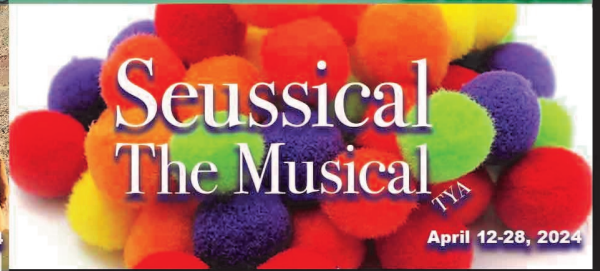
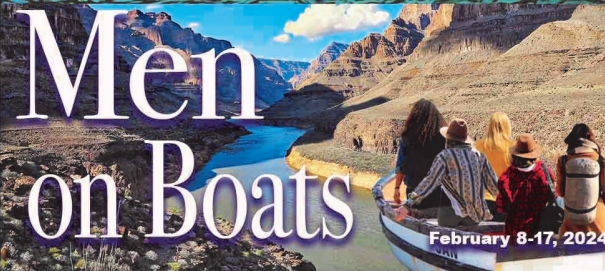
