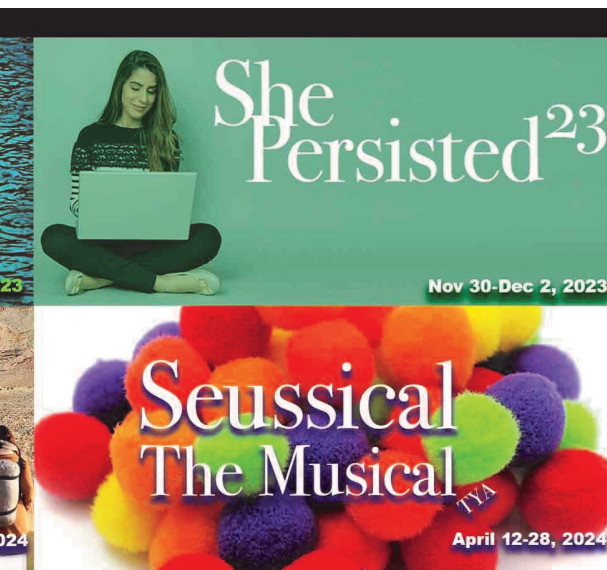
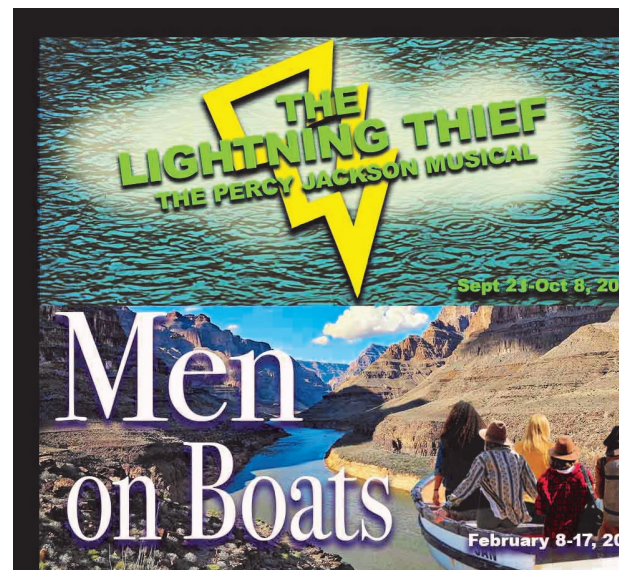
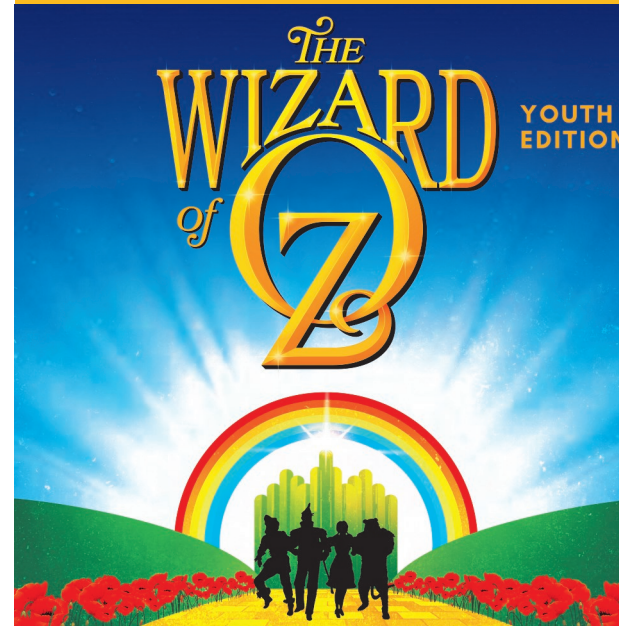

Grandstreet Theatre School helps develop young actors and theatre-makers, age 5-18, through our after-school programming. During the school year, students attend classes once a week with others in the same age group. There are three school year sessions, however some classes require a full year commitment (see below).

Grandstreet's Theatre School expands student skills in character development, improvisation, and playmaking while providing practical experience in rehearsal techniques. Classwork is aimed at building character—both on and off the stage—and providing arts education that inspires creative thinking, self-confidence, effective communication skills, fluid movement and vocal control. Each student receives training in acting, voice and diction, singing, movement, dance improvisation, musical theatre, and directing.

NOTE: Attending Session 1 qualifies the student to audition for *The Wizard of Oz, Youth Edition*.

## **MEET THE PRODUCTION TEAM**

**Jeff Downing (Director, Production Designer)** (he/him) is originally from Chillicothe, OH, and received a BFA from the University of Cincinnati, College-Conservatory of Music. After ten years of directing, designing, and teaching in New York City, he moved to Helena in 2012 to become Grandstreet's Artistic Director. Jeff has directed and designed many shows at GST, most recently *Bright Star*, *The Mousetrap*, *Roald Dahl's Matilda the Musical*, *Admissions*, *Murder on the Orient Express*, *The Bridges of Madison County*, and *The Book of Will*. He is also the playwright of *A Real Boy*, which premiered at Grandstreet in January. Some of Jeff's favorite roles on the Grandstreet stage include Marvin in *Falsettos*, Tateh in *Ragtime*, and the Baker in *Into the Woods*. 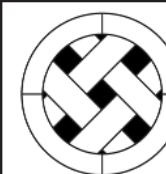
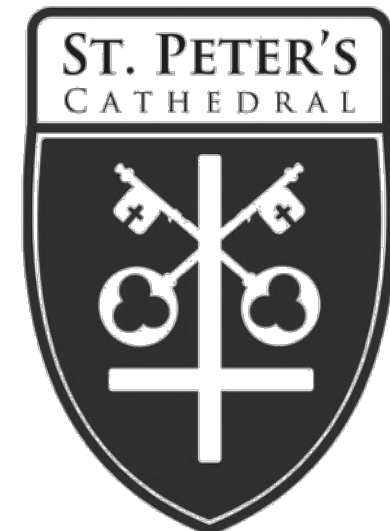
